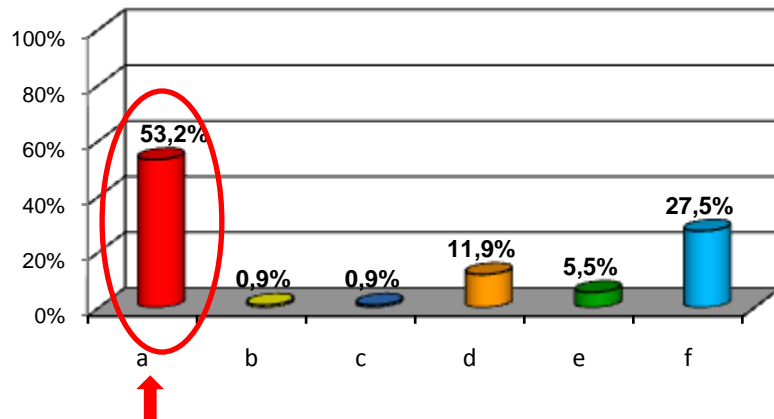

- f) I do not know; I'm coming to learn.

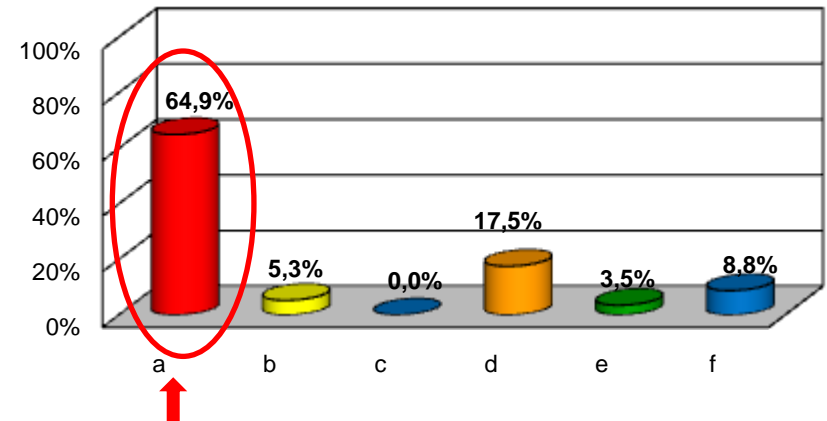
